The Mozambique Orphanage Fund (MOF) is a 501(c) (3) Public Charity. Its purpose is to raise money to provide food, clothing, education, and care for orphans and vulnerable children in Mozambique. We also work as an advocate with other partners to gain additional support for the needs of these children.

Our first priority is to support the needs of the Carolyn Belshe Orphanage (CBO) in Cambine, Mozambique. After satisfying that need, we will raise money for other orphanages or agencies supporting orphans and vulnerable children in Mozambique. We will be supporting a new orphanage in Dondo, Mozambique which is expected to start up in 2018

In February of 2017 CBO was hit by Cyclone Dineo, which caused damage estimate to cost \$58,000 to repair. MOF funded \$45,000 of this cost. As of the end of 2017 all but one house (The Director's house) was repaired and the children were back in their dorms.

What we accomplished in 2017:

- Funded Reconstruction from effects of Cyclone Dineo.
- Funded 25% of the budget at CBO,
- Funded the Bread Oven Operation at CBO
- Funded Early Childhood Learning Program at CBO
- Purchased school supplies at CBO
- Provided Shoes and Clothing at CBO
- Funded Christmas celebration, and provided presents for every child at CBO
- Completed construction of security fence at CBO
- Funded th CBO Agriculture Project
- Provided 4 Full University Scholarships for CBO secondary school graduates
- Supported the Orphan Feeding Program in Dondo, Mozambique which is the site of the new orphanage under construction.
- Most importantly-brought hope and Christ's love to them all!
